DID YOU KNOW?

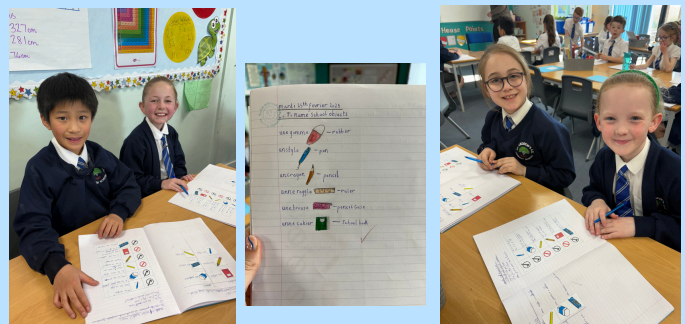


1. Learning a new language increases your attention span and makes you concentrate for longer!
