4. Boothstown is in Salford, which is a city in Greater Manchester.
5. There is a canal that runs through Boothstown.
6. St. Andrew's C.E. Primary School is on Vicars Hall Lane.
7. Leigh Road is the main road that leads into Boothstown.
8. Boothstown is close to a dual carriageway called the East Lancs Road (A580).
9. The closest airport to Boothstown is Manchester airport.
10. The closest train station to Boothstown is Walkden train station.
11. Boothstown has four seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter.
12. Lots of local amenities are situated on the Standfield Centre.
