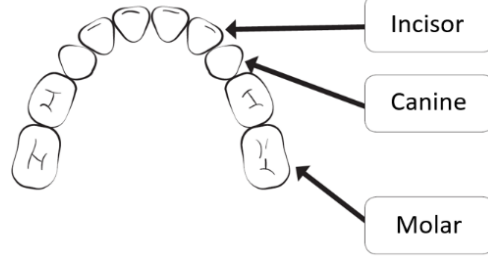

## What should I know already

- The parts of the human body and what they do.
- All animals need water, air and food to survive.
- The different ways in which humans are healthy.
- Humans and some animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

## Vocabulary

Canine	Pointed teeth near the front of the mouth
Incisor	Teeth at the front of the mouth used for biting
Molar	Large flat tooth at the back of the mouth.
Oesophagus	Carries food from the mouth to the stomach.
Enamel	The hard, white coating on a tooth.
Saliva	Watery liquid that forms in our mouth to help digestion.
Intestines	The tubes in your body that food passes through
Plaque	Contains bacteria and forms on the surface of teeth.
Pre-Molar	Two on each side of the jaw, between the canine and molars.
Producer	An organism that makes its own food.
Predator	An animal that hunts and eats other animals.
Prey	An animal that is hunted and eaten by other animals.

By the end of the unit, I will know:

1. Incisors bite into food.
2. Canines rip and tear food.
3. Molars crush and grind food.
4. The smell of food triggers saliva.
5. The oesophagus takes food from the mouth to the stomach.
6. The liver produces bile to help digest food.
7. A carnivore only eats meat
8. A herbivore only eats vegetables.
9. The arrows in a food chain show the direction of energy.
