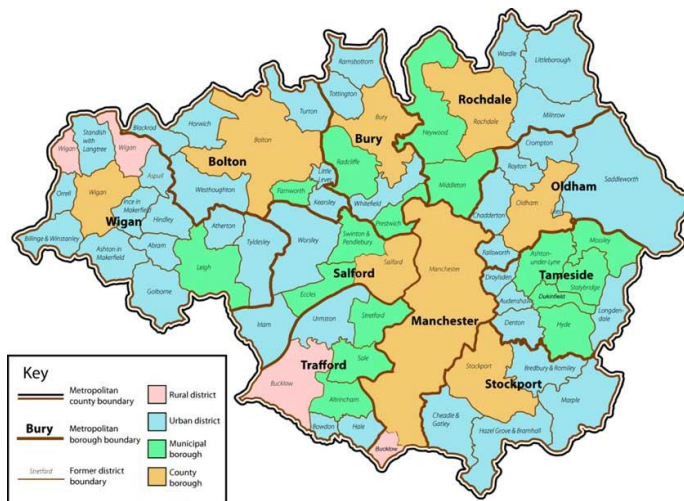


## Key Vocabulary
