Nursery Fund

Snack

Milk and fruit are provided daily for the children. We also add extra snacks paid for from the Nursery fund. Children decide when they are hungry and want to eat their snack. This encourages independence. Water is available all day for them which is why we do not need water bottles. There is a menu in the café to promote 'making sense of print' for the children. The children learn to share, take turns, communicate, spread (butter/cheese), pour and tidy up. The cups are washed in hot soapy water by a teacher throughout the day.

PTA

Star of the Week
 We will choose a star of the week on a Friday afternoon for somebody that is showing our Christian values. This child will receive a gold medal to keep. Throughout the year, everybody will have a turn.

SHOW AND TELL
 In circle time on a Friday we will have 'show and tell'. Autumn's 'show and tell' theme will be 'We Love Books'. Children are invited to bring a photograph of themselves reading in an unusual place and a copy of one of their favourite books (with their name in please). We will send you a timetable of which Friday is your child's Show and Tell day.

Water Bottles
 Children in Nursery do not need to bring a water bottle into class as they have access to water all day. We encourage the children to pour their own water and then put their dirty cup into the sink for the teacher to wash. We have found it unhygienic for water bottles in Nursery as some children will just drink from any. Pouring their own water encourages independence and good fine motor skills.

Wetsuits and Wellies
 We will be teaching children how to put on wetsuits so they can access the outdoor water, sand and digging areas. Please ensure your child has a pair of wellies with their name on. Please leave these in school on their class stand.

Book Bags
 Please could we ask for the book bags to be brought into school everyday. It is important that the children get used to this as we will pass letters, information and eventually reading diaries in their book bags. Please empty these bags daily as letters can be lost in 'busy' bags. Could we also ask that only one key ring be attached to the bag, if any? Otherwise they do not fit into their tray. Thank you.

Weekend Story
 Every half term, Mrs Platt and Mrs Green will upload a video reading one of our core stories for that half term. This will be posted onto the school website during the last week of each half term.

READING SUITCASE
 Part of phonics in Nursery is ensuring that the children 'read for pleasure'. This gives them the time to really 'enjoy' books and share them with the people they love. We will send home a 'reading suitcase'. This will contain a book, teddy bear, hot chocolate, marshmallows and a journal to record something about the book (maybe your favourite part, the characters or even draw a picture). This will be sent home on a Friday. Please return it on the following Monday. Every child will have a turn.

P.E
 Physical Education is on a Wednesday afternoon for one hour with 'Ed Start' (an outside sports agency). Children do not need pumps until November - for our Nativity show.

ERIC
 To foster a 'love of reading' in Nursery, each Monday or Tuesday the children will take part in 'ERIC' (Everybody reading in class). This is a relaxing 15 minute reading session on the carpet in which the children will choose a book from the reading basket to enjoy and share with their friends. We will provide the books.

Class reward system
 Our Nursery reward system is taken from the book, 'Have you filled your bucket today?' Every child has their own bucket for pom-poms which are given for good manners etc. (or taken out if they 'make the wrong choice'). When their bucket is full, they will receive a prize and begin again.

NUTS
 This year, we have children in the nursery with nut allergies. Please could we ask you to only send in 'non nut based sweets' for birthdays, school trips, packed lunches or if you bring your child a treat at the end of the day. Any birthday treats sent in should be given to the class teacher and be pre packaged and contain an ingredient label. Thank you in advance for making Nursery a safe and healthy place for our children. By working together we can make a difference.

Nursery Library
 Library will take place on a Friday. Children are able to choose a library book to borrow and take home to read. Please ensure this is returned in their bag the following Friday, otherwise they will not be able to choose a new book. Library will begin in the first week after half term.

Autumn walk
 Every October we go on an autumn 'learning walk' to a local 'park'. This year this will take place on Tuesday 8th October. If you would like to volunteer to support us walk the children there please see the class teacher. The walk usually lasts from 9.15am to 10.15am.

Dinner choice
 Children that are on school dinners will have a choice of what they would like to eat. This is chosen the day before by them looking at a picture of the four options available. Known dietary requirements will be adhered to.
