Uniform and Equipment

Please may we appeal to parents that all uniform is clearly labelled with **children's names** to try to cut down on the amount of lost property and the time spent trying to find its owner. It would be useful if any packed lunch boxes are also labelled. Also, we ask that the children bring a water bottle into school so they have access to a drink when they want one, although this must be water during lessons. In year 5, children are still able to bring in a healthy snack for playtime, such as fruit, rice cakes, cereal bars, cheese, crackers etc. **Could we please remind parents that snacks, packed lunches and birthday treats brought into school should not contain nuts of any kind as we have children in our year group with a nut allergy.**

Homework

The English and Maths books have stayed the same as last year. The children will be given certain pages in the books to complete, related to the work that they have been looking at in class. If there are any questions that the children are struggling with they can come and see us and we will go through it with them. **English homework is due back on a Wednesday and Maths on a Friday.**
