Water Bottles

Children in Nursery do not need to bring a water bottle into class as they have access to water all day. We encourage the children to pour their own water and then put their dirty cup into the sink for the teacher to wash. We have found it unhygienic for water bottles in Nursery as some children will just drink from any. Pouring their own water encourages independence and good fine motor skills. This also applies in the hot weather please.

Sun cream

As the weather heats up, please apply sun cream to your child in the morning. If needed, we will reapply this in the afternoon. Please do not send in sun cream as we will provide a sensitive one for the class.

Stick Insects

Our class stick insects are big and strong now. If any of the children would like to take them home for the weekend or over the half term, please let the class teacher know. They will just need some fresh ivy to replace the old leaves.

Book Bags

Please could we ask for the book bags to be brought into school everyday? It is important that the children get used to this as we will pass letters, information and reading diaries through the book bag. We encourage the children to read at home as well as in school. If their reading record is marked, we will reward them with a pom pom for their bucket.



Read Write Inc.

Nursery have now begun Read Write Inc. in phonics. We are learning the sounds, words that begin with those sounds, air writing the letter and 'Fred talking' words (oral blending).
