We are working in partnership with Christian Aid on their scheme called 'Global Neighbours.' The children plus staff, governors and parents at St Andrew's can all be Global Neighbours. The Global Neighbours Team includes a representative from each class of Years 1 to 6. This team has been considering some of the issues we face globally and finding ways we can all 'make a change.' The children have fully participated in this initiative and really enjoyed learning about their place in the wider world and considered how they can tackle in justice. They have already led several initiatives both in school and in the local community. These include:

- Considering ways we could reduce the amount of traffic congestion around school at peak times
- Leading a campaign to promote Fairtrade products in our local Sainsburys
- Interviewing The Mayor of Salford to learn about the Council's plans regarding homelessness and global warming
- Leading a whole school assembly on ways to reduce global warming
- 'Litter picking' in our local area with our local councillor
- Supporting Reverend Owens in her drive to become an eco church
- Contacting the company which delivers fruit to school to enquire whether they could provide alternative packaging to plastic
- Being a collection point for Duracell, collecting used batteries from our homes and the community
- Organising a bake sale in aid of The Ace Grace Foundation and Dementia UK.
