Leavers' Assembly

On the yearly school calendar of events, the leavers' assembly was scheduled for Monday 20th July, however this will now take place on **Friday 17th July @ 9.30am in the school hall**. The children will be creating invites as part of our computing lessons with the full details on, so keep an eye out for those later in the term!

SATs Week and SATs breakfast

SATs week is nearly upon us and we just wanted to say a massive well done to all the children who over the last few weeks have been working incredibly hard. Please try and keep their minds off the tests and keep them relaxed throughout this next two weeks. The tests will be in the following order:

Monday 11th May: Spelling, punctuation and grammar – SPAG

Tuesday 12th May: Reading

Wednesday 13th May: Arithmetic and maths reasoning one

Thursday 14th May: Maths reasoning two

During test week itself, we will once again be opening the doors of the forum at 8.30am for the children of year 6 to come along nice and early and get themselves settled and relaxed. There will be a variety of breakfast juices and snacks on offer for the children to eat whilst we go over some last minute tips ahead of their tests and settle any last minute nerves. If you cannot make it any earlier then do not worry. Also, please do not panic if you are stuck in any traffic on the morning of the tests, please inform the office that you're running late and try to stay calm, we promise we won't start until everyone is here and ready. Also, if your child falls ill during SATs week, please ring school as early as possible so we can make any necessary arrangements. All tests will be sat in the morning of each day and the children will then get some extra playtime and some light revision in the afternoon before finishing the day at the usual time.

The children have been working ever so hard and should all be feeling confident going into these exams and we know they will all do fantastically well. A reminder that all papers are sent off to be externally marked and we won't receive the results until the middle of July – we will share these with you alongside your child's report at the end of the year.
