At school you learn a lot, but why? It is to make you knowledgeable and skilled for the future. All of the subjects you learn are linked to careers that adults have in the world.

Have a look below – which subject is your favourite and where might it take you in the future?

Mathematics Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? The logical thinking, problem-solving and decision-making skills you learn while studying mathematics are highly valued across many job sectors. Maths can lead directly to related careers in accountancy, engineering, teacher, investment analyst, quantity surveyor, architects, tradesperson, nursing, agriculturists, biologists, chemists and pilot.

English Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? There are many career pathways that you could aim for if you choose to study English at a higher level, such as: Author, Editor, Technical Writer, Scribe, Reporter, Teacher, Paralegal, Lawyer, Librarian, Publisher, Copywriter, Researcher.

Religious Education Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Career paths in RE and the skills you acquire through its study are wide-ranging. They include: Charity Fundraiser, Charity Officer, School Chaplain, Primary School Teacher, High School Teacher, Youth Worker, Community Development Worker, Higher Education Lecturer, Newspaper Journalist, Mediator, Equality, Diversity and Inclusion Officer, Roman Catholic Priest, Nun.

Science Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Careers in science (across biology, chemistry and physics) include researching, designing and developing new products. Careers in technology include working in IT, managing and using information and working with digital media. You might be based in a hospital, laboratory, university, factory or office.

Careers in Science, technology and IT are varied and interesting. You could travel the world doing scientific research, develop a life-saving drug, discover a new creature or create a new mobile phone app.

Physical Education Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Career paths in PE and the skills you acquire through its study are varied. They include: Leisure management, teaching, sports development, sports psychology, sports science, personal trainer, sociology, psychology, medicine, health, fitness and well-being, anatomy and physiology.

Computing Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Computing can lead directly to related careers in software development, cyber-security expert, engineering, app development, website development, IT consultancy, electronic engineering, and computer forensics. The course content is also highly relevant to other technical areas such as chemical and mechanical engineering and architectural design.

Geography Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Careers in Geography are varied because students develop analytical skills and their passion and drive can lead to careers in a range of different fields. Example destinations of Geography students include: Planning and administration; Tourism industry; Education; Environmental; Journalism; Surveying; Transport, broadcasting; Oil industry; Archaeology; Politics; Architect; Law.

History Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Career paths involving history and the skills you acquire through its study are varied: They include the armed forces, law, media and journalism, marketing, central government and the European community, museum work, teaching, the oil industry, accountancy and business.

French Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Working in a business which works with other businesses abroad, working for our government in areas which work with people abroad, working in finance (with money), buying and selling with companies abroad, advertising, working for TV programmes or the news, teaching, working in the holiday/travel business.

Music Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Freelance performance, orchestral or choral performance, teaching (privately or school), composition for media, film and concerts, arts management, music production, sound technician, sound engineering, acoustics, music copyright, radio, lyricist, music journalism, events management, musical theatre.

Design and Technology Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Graphic design, interior/exhibition design, product design, production engineering, architecture, project planning, teaching, illustration, advertising and media.

Art and Design Career Pathways

What sorts of career paths are open to me? Pupils who have studied art have gone on to a wide variety of careers including; architecture, graphic design; digital media, web design, computer games design and animation, photography, film-maker and director.
